Day 1

Private transfer to Cayo District.

Maya sites include Caracol, Xunantunich, Pacbitun, El Pilar, Cahal Pech, and many other smaller sites. Sensational topography and endless opportunities for adventure; such as canoeing, cave tubing, zip-lines, hiking, horseback riding and mountain biking, make the region a cure for wanderlust.

duPlooy's is a small jungle lodge on the Macal River, 10 miles from San Ignacio, where guests feel right at home relaxed in the friendly surroundings. The Lodge Rooms are spacious and very comfortable; amenities include: 2 queen-sized beds, large private bath, screened porch and lots of windows. duPlooy's is well known for its "Hangover" deck and bar, which hangs out over the bush looking down into the Macal River. This is a perfect spot for discussing the day's adventures, evening star gazing or early morning bird watching. The lodge's dining room is a simple wood and stone structure next to the deck, where lunch and dinner are served. Lunch can also be served as a picnic. There are plenty of activities right on the premises - swimming in the waters of the Macal River, relaxing on a beautiful sandy beach, canoeing, horseback riding or visiting the adjacent Belize Botanic Garden. Bird watching can be done in a civilized fashion right from duPlooy's deck with its 200 foot canopied walkway; from the bird blind in the

Botanic Garden or walking leisurely about the property. The Botanic Garden is a 45-acre reserve with several miles of trails, a small hardwood forest area, a Mayan area complete with a typical hut and plants that are still being used by the Maya; a pond featuring aquatic plants of Belize; palm, sustainable forest and tropical fruit projects for demonstration and economic purposes and an orchid house featuring nearly 200 species of native Belizean Orchids.

Xunantunich Maya Site

Visit the Ix Chel Tropical Research Farm and the Panti Maya Medicine Trail to learn about the practical, medicinal and other traditional uses of the local flora. Xunantunich in Maya is "The Stone Maiden". The site is about 30 minutes from San Ignacio and is only accessible by taking a hand-cranked ferry across the Mopan River. Xunantunich is one of the most popular Maya sites in Belize and was one of the first to be excavated and opened to the public. Standing atop "El Castillo", the largest pyramid at the site, you will have a panoramic view of western Belize and eastern Guatemala .

Ambergris Caye is the largest and best known of all the 200 or so cayes (pronounced keys) in Belize. Sun-drenched and fringed with coconut palms, Ambergris Caye stretches north to south for over 25 miles, running just inside Belize's magnificent barrier reef. The island's eastern side is fringed with beaches, and faces the nearby reef. The western shore is laced with healthy patches of mangrove, and is rich with wildlife. Most of the island's inhabitants live in the town of San Pedro, located in the southern part of the caye. San Pedro has the cozy, laid-back atmosphere of a small village with its wooden houses and sand streets. Apart from the pleasures of taking it easy and enjoying life on Ambergris, the caye has the widest range of water-sports and is well positioned for day trips to many attractions in the area.

With its Mayan inspired design and seaside setting, Ramon's Village exudes an exotic tropical atmosphere perfect for romance, relaxation and fun. Sixty-one thatch roofed cabanas, hidden beneath coconut palms, are just steps away from the white sand beach and cerulean waters of the Western Caribbean. Each is simply furnished in island style, featuring hand rubbed mahogany floors, rattan furniture, air-conditioning, shower bathroom and private deck. The resort's centerpiece is the lushly foliaged eighty-foot lagoon-style pool with waterfall. Savor a delicious beach barbeque or join in the entertainment at the world famous Purple Parrot Bar. Enjoy a romantic dinner at the Restaurant at Ramon's as the gentle breezes mingled with the perfume of tropical flowers whirl you into a savoring calm. (Do note only beer and wine served at this resort - you can bring your own liquor upon the property.) A full-service dive shop offers guided excursions to the barrier reef, two rare and breathtaking atolls and the famous Blue Hole aboard their Pro 42 dive boat, Miss Gina. Resort and full certification

courses are available. Fishing, snorkeling, water-skiing, windsurfing, hobie-cat sailing and glass bottom canoeing are among the available activities. Bicycles, golf carts and motor scooters may be rented for exploring, and the popular village of San Pedro is just a short walk away.

Shark Ray Alley & Hol Chan Snorkel Excursion (2 stops)

A snorkel adventure awaits you at Hol Chan Marine Reserve! Depart from San Pedro by boat and head south east to Hol Chan (Maya for “Little Channel”), the first marine reserve established in Central America. Explore the coral reefs as you swim amongst the abundant marine life. Then head to your second snorkel stop, Shark Ray Alley. Friendly reef fish including snappers and jacks dart in and about graceful stingrays and the inquisitive brown nurse sharks for an experience not to be missed. After your personal encounter with the “friendly critters” you will be transferred back to the Town of San Pedro.
